2014

Changed name to the **Electrical Industries Charity**.

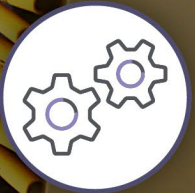

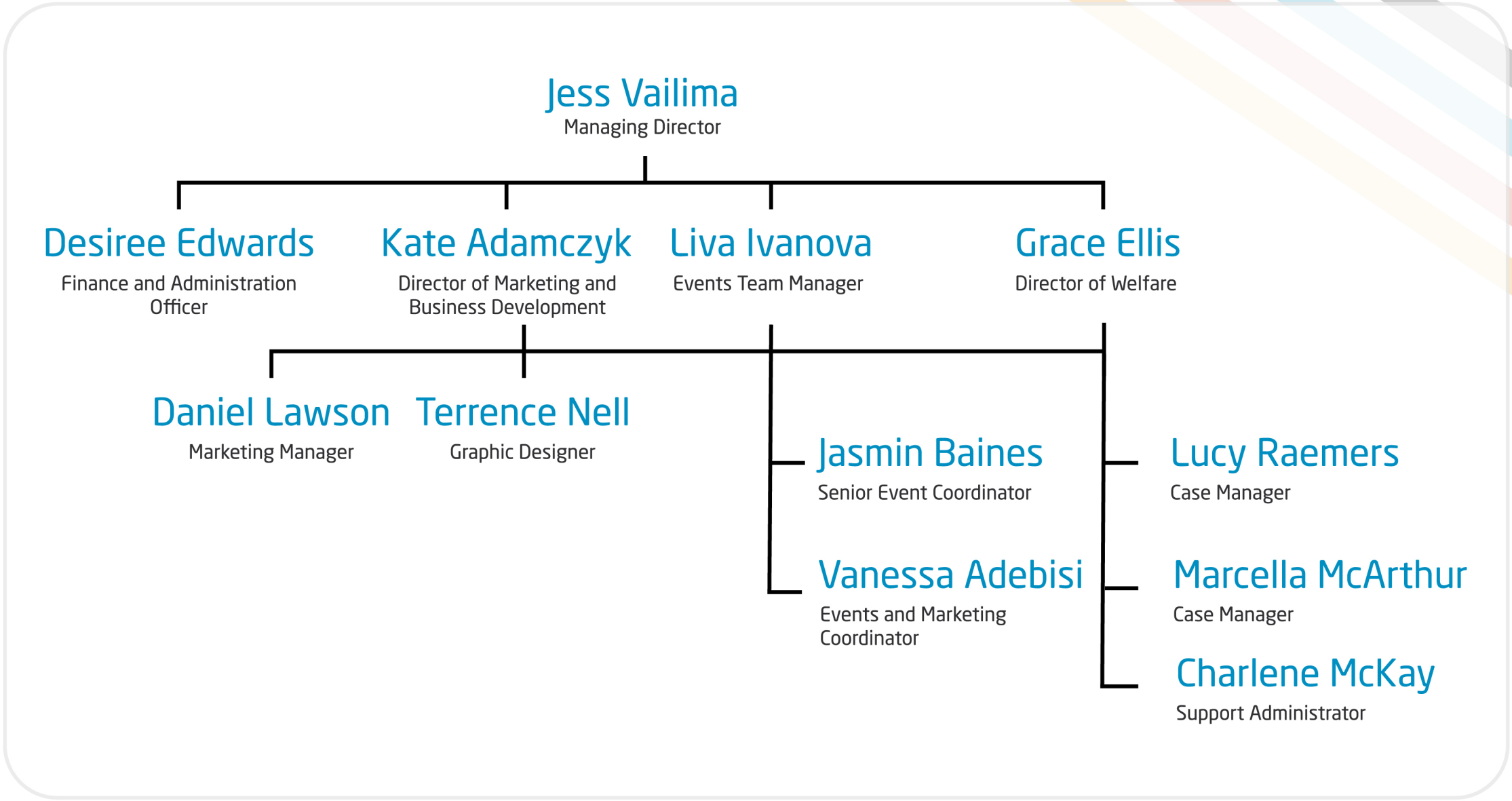


How can you support Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in your business?



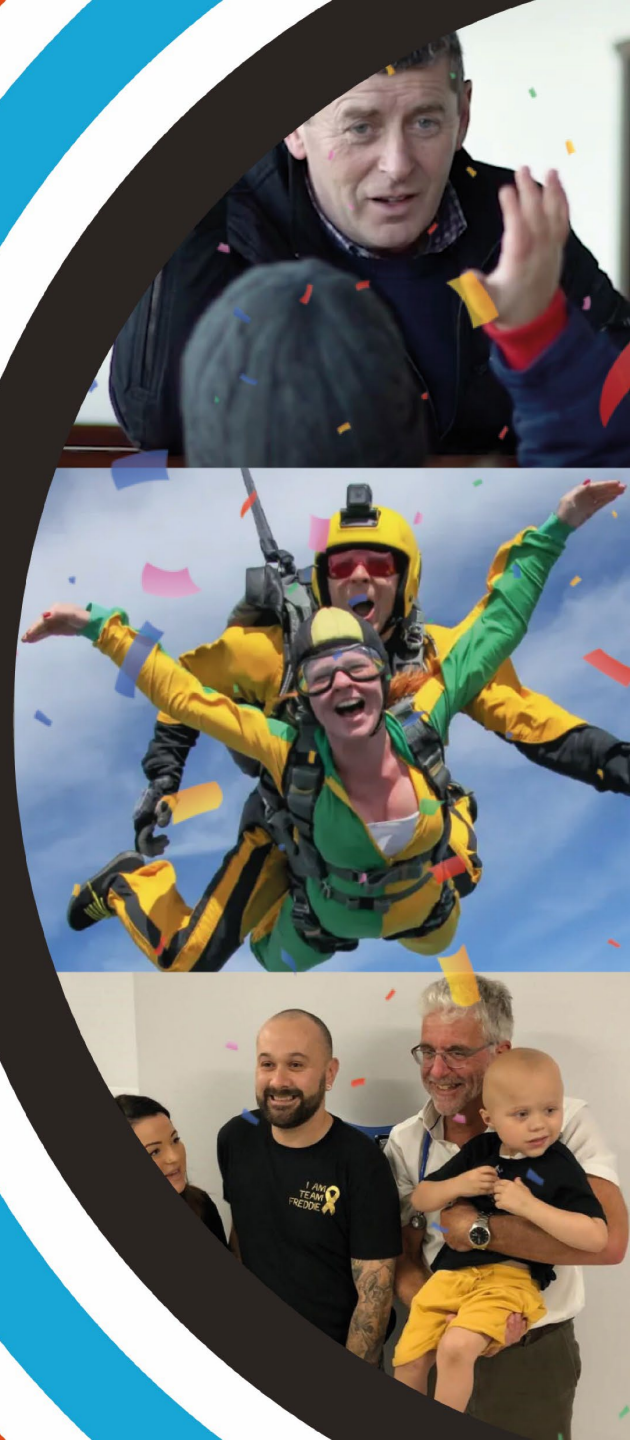
